10 SIGNS TO WATCH FOR

1. Decreased Appetite

Lack of interest or change in habits



6. Excessive Grooming

Focuses grooming in one location

2. Bathroom Habits

Changes in urination or defecation routine



7. Decreased Grooming

Overall decrease in normal grooming

3. Sensitive to Touch

Whimpering or crying when touched near joints



8. Hunched Position

Hunches or tucks in when sleeping

4. Difficulty Jumping

Trouble climbing furniture, bed, steps and more



9. Behavior Change

Seeks solitude, or is aggressive

5. Reduced Activity

Reluctance to get up, lie down, or walk



10. Squinting

Keeps eyes squinted regardless of light
